## **Materials You'll Need:**

- DK weight yarn in your desired color (approximately 250-300g)
- Crochet hook size 4mm
- Yarn needle
- Buttons (optional)

## **Skill Level:**

Beginner-friendly

## **Stitches Used:**

- Single crochet (sc)
- Double crochet (dc)
- Slip stitch (sl st)
- Ribbing stitch (explained in pattern)

## **Pattern Instructions:**

**Note:** UK terminology is used throughout the pattern.

### **Part 1: Back Panel**

1. Ch 60.
2. Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Turn. (58 dc)
3. Row 2: Ch 3, turn. Dc in each dc across. Turn. (58 dc)
4. Repeat Row 2 until back panel measures approximately 15cm from beginning.

## **Part 2: Sleeves**

1. Ch 26.
2. Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Turn. (24 dc)
3. Row 2: Ch 3, turn. Dc in each dc across. Turn. (24 dc)
4. Repeat Row 2 until sleeve measures approximately 12cm from beginning.

## **Part 3: Front Panels (Make 2)**

1. Ch 36.
2. Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Turn. (34 dc)
3. Row 2: Ch 3, turn. Dc in each dc across. Turn. (34 dc)
4. Repeat Row 2 until front panel measures approximately 15cm from beginning.

## **Part 4: Ribbing**

1. Join yarn to the bottom right corner of the back panel and sl st into each stitch along the bottom edge of the back panel. Turn.
2. Row 1: \*Sc in next dc, dc in next dc\*. Repeat from \* to \* across. Turn. (29 ribs)
3. Row 2: \*Sc in next dc, dc in next dc\*. Repeat from \* to \* across. Turn. (29 ribs)
4. Repeat Row 2 until ribbing measures approximately 3cm from beginning.

## **Part 5: Sleeves (Continue from Part 2)**

1. Join yarn to the bottom edge of one sleeve and sl st into each stitch along the bottom edge. Turn.
2. Follow the same ribbing instructions as in Part 4 to create ribbing around the bottom edge of the sleeve.

## Part 6: Collar

1. Join yarn to the center back of the neck and sl st into each stitch along the back neck edge. Turn.



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
