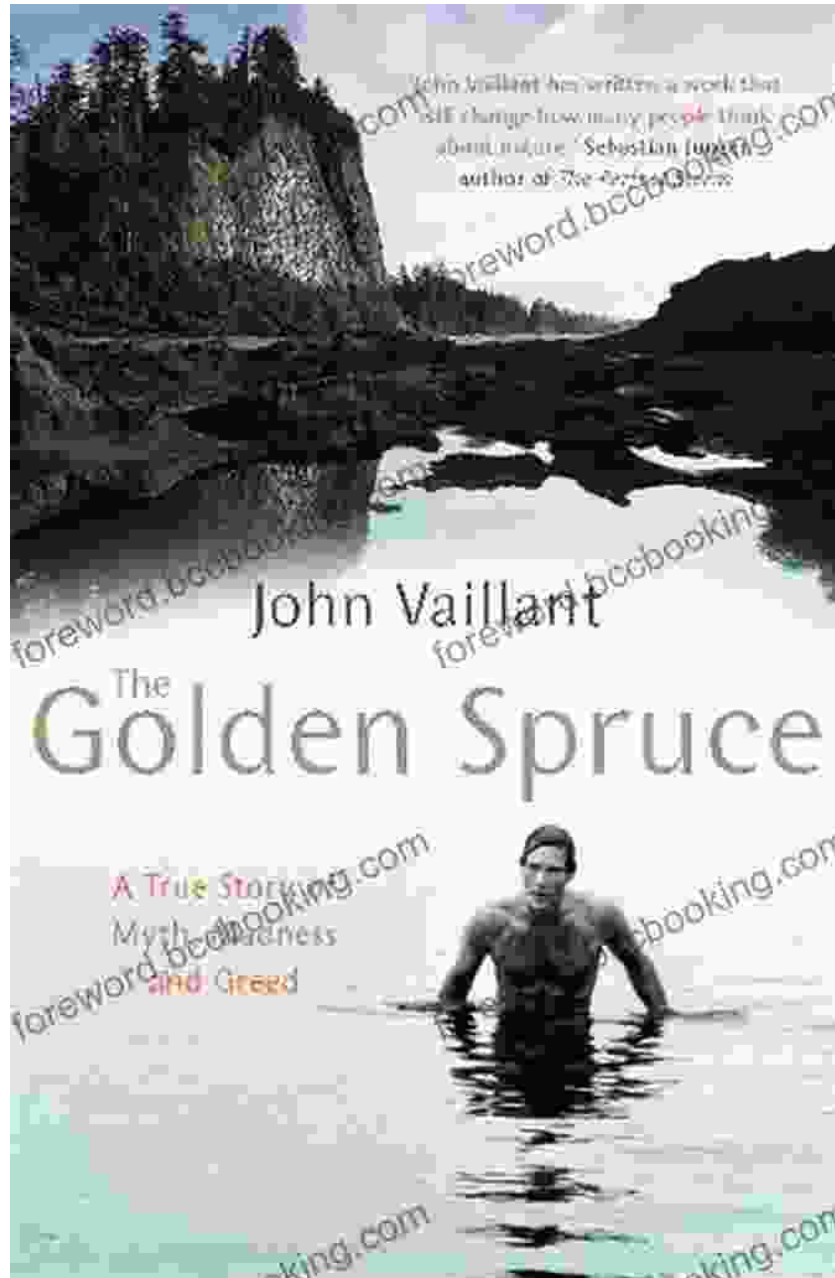
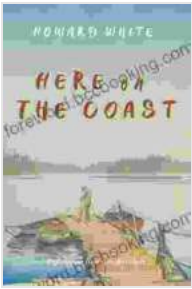

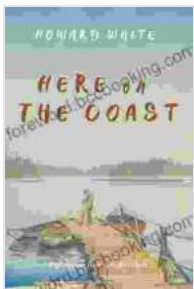

Vaillant has written for *The New York Times Magazine*, *National Geographic*, and *The Atlantic*, among other publications. He lives on the coast of British Columbia.

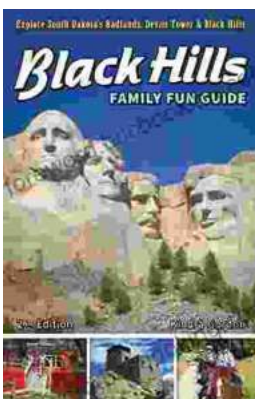
